1. A new KIS portal

 Educators can now apply for KIS support using a centralised, online portal. The process is clearer more streamlined.



2. Updated guidelines

 The KIS guidelines have been revised to improve clarity and better align with the application process. They provide improved transparency about the processing and assessment of applications.



3. Greater clarity

- Roles and responsibilities for educators, families,
 Program Support Groups, allied health and other professionals are now more clearly defined.
- The new KIS guidelines use language that better reflects inclusive practice. This is to designed to further support children's full participation in kindergarten.



4. Quicker application outcomes

 Kindergarten services now receive faster outcomes, with typical turnaround times reduced from 4 weeks to 2 weeks.
