1. A new KIS portal

- Educators can now apply for KIS support using a centralised, online portal. The process is clearer more streamlined.



2. Updated guidelines

- The KIS guidelines have been revised to improve clarity and better align with the application process. They provide improved transparency about the processing and assessment of applications.



3. Greater clarity

- Roles and responsibilities for educators, families, Program Support Groups, allied health and other professionals are now more clearly defined.
- The new KIS guidelines use language that better reflects inclusive practice. This is to designed to further support children's full participation in kindergarten.



4. Quicker application outcomes

- Kindergarten services now receive faster outcomes, with typical turnaround times reduced from 4 weeks to 2 weeks.
